

2019 Menai Strait Regatta Rowing

Background

The Menai Strait Regatta has been held in August since 1826. The earliest races were for Rowing and Sail, it is the aim of the organizers to resurrect the tradition of having rowing boats taking part in the Regatta with the classic sailing boats.

This year we are holding 4 days of rowing to coincide with the sailing schedule, each day will have a different location on the Strait and will be varied in length. With the longer passages we will race part of it, sightseeing and stopping will be an option. Clubs can change rowers each day if they wish. Entry fee £15 per boat per day.

Day 1- Royal Anglesey Yacht Club

Wednesday 7th August row through from Beaumaris to Caernarfon
Start time: 13:00. Followed by prize giving RWYC.

Day 2 -Royal Welsh Yacht Club

Thursday 8th August Caernarfon to Fort-Belan and back to Caernarfon
Start time: 13:15. prize giving in RWYC

Day 3- Caernarfon Sailing Club

Friday 9th August Course around and through sand banks.
Start time: 15:15. Prize giving at CSC

Day 4- Port Dinorwic Regatta

Saturday 10th August Sprint races.
Start time TBC. Prize giving ashore in Port Dinorwic.
